Green building certificates are a driver for building development and management to promote indoor air quality (IAQ). We welcome the [consultation](#) of BEAM Society Limited on BEAM Plus Existing Buildings v3.0, one of its schemes, and recommend the following:

- Provide additional credits for the publication of real-time IAQ data to occupants and the public;
- Introduction of credits for buildings that comply with indoor pollutant levels or formulating a response mechanism;
- Introduction of credits for tenant initiatives that cover IAQ;
- Publication of scorecards of individual buildings.
